## Decision of the Chair, Workers' Compensation Appeal Tribunal

- 1. Whereas under section 234 of the *Workers Compensation Act* (the Act) the chair is responsible for the general operation of the Workers' Compensation Appeal Tribunal ("WCAT");
- 2. And whereas the chair's authority includes responsibility, among other things, for:
  - establishing any rules, forms, practices and procedures required for the efficient and cost effective conduct of appeals to WCAT,
  - making accessible to the public any rules, forms, practices and procedures established by the chair;
  - establishing administrative practices and procedures for the effective operation of WCAT;
  - providing for public access to WCAT decisions in a manner that protects the privacy of the parties to the proceedings; and,
  - establishing a code of conduct, including conflict of interest provisions, that governs the conduct of the members, officers, employees and contractors of WCAT.
  - 3. Pursuant to my authority under Part 4 of the Act, the rules, practices and procedures contained in the attached *Manual of Rules, Practices and Procedures* dated March 3, 2003 are now established.
  - 4. These rules, practices and procedures remain in effect until their amendment, replacement or revocation by the chair.
