Decision of the Chair, Workers' Compensation Appeal Tribunal

Number:3Date:September 26, 2003Subject:Voluntary "Parking Lot" for Transition Appeals

- 1. Whereas under section 234 of the *Workers Compensation Act* (the Act) the chair is responsible for the general operation of the Workers' Compensation Appeal Tribunal ("WCAT").
- 2. And whereas the chair's authority includes responsibility for:
 - establishing any rules, forms, practices and procedures required for the efficient and cost effective conduct of appeals to WCAT;
 - making accessible to the public any rules, forms, practices and procedures established by the chair; and,
 - establishing administrative practices and procedures for the effective operation of WCAT.
- 3. And whereas the chair's authority under section 43 of Part 2 of the *Workers Compensation Amendment Act (No. 2), 2002* (the Amendment Act) includes responsibility for establishing rules, forms, practices and procedures for the efficient and cost effective conduct of proceedings before WCAT under the transitional provisions contained in Part 2 of the Amendment Act.
- 4. Pursuant to the above-noted authority under the Act and the Amendment Act, the attached rules, practices and procedures, set out as items 26.60 to 26.69, are now established as an amendment to the *Manual of Rules, Practices and Procedures*.
- 5. These rules, practices and procedures remain in effect until their amendment, replacement or revocation by the chair.
