Subject: Manual of Rules, Practices and Procedures

- 1. In Decision of the Chair No. 4, a revised *Manual of Rules, Practices and Procedures* (MRPP) dated March 29, 2004, was approved as an amendment and replacement of the MRPP effective March 29, 2004.
- 2. To correct an error in the text, item #5.31 of the MRPP is now amended to insert "30 or" before each reference to a 90-day time limit:

Additionally, in considering whether acts and omissions of representatives constitute special circumstances that precluded the filing of the appeal on time, WCAT will take into account the following factors (see *WCAT Decision* #2003-04175):

- (a) whether there is evidence that the party intended to request a review within the <u>30 or</u> 90-day time limit through instructing the representative to do so;
- (b) whether there is evidence that the party gave instructions promptly (early in the 30 or 90-day period);
- (c) whether the party followed up with the representative within the 30 or 90-day time limit to ensure that the representative acted in accordance with the party's instructions;
- 3. These rules, practices and procedures remain in effect until their amendment, replacement or revocation by the chair.
