Appeal of judicial review decision – extension of time – indigent status

This was an application to the Court of Appeal for indigent status and an extension of time to bring an application for leave to appeal a judicial review decision.

Dekan Redae applied for indigent status and an extension of time to bring an application for leave to appeal from the B.C. Supreme Court decision dismissing her judicial review petition. In that petition, she sought an order setting aside a decision of the Workers' Compensation Appeal Tribunal (WCAT) made on 18 October 2007 summarily dismissing her appeal of a decision of the Review Division of the Workers' Compensation Board (Board), dated 24 April 2006. The appellant took the position that the chamber's judge had not made a mistake; rather her issue was with the denial of her claim, which was not the subject matter of the WCAT decision or the judicial review. The Court dismissed the applications on the ground that the proposed appeal had no merit.
