



**WORKERS' COMPENSATION APPEAL TRIBUNAL (WCAT)
QUARTERLY REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY
FOR THE PERIOD ENDED JUNE 30, 2008**

WCAT commenced operations on March 3, 2003. Our mandate is to decide appeals brought by workers and employers from decisions of the Workers' Compensation Board, operating as WorkSafeBC (the Board). WCAT receives compensation, assessment, and prevention appeals from decisions of the Review Division of the Board. We also receive direct appeals from Board decisions regarding compensation claim reopenings by application, discriminatory action complaints, and applications for certificates to the Court.

As of June 30, 2008, our total active inventory was 3,188 appeals.

During the second quarter of 2008, we decided 1,025 appeals on their merits and made summary decisions on a further 302 appeals that were rejected, dismissed, withdrawn, or suspended. During the quarter, WCAT confirmed the decision of the Board or the previous decision-maker in 60% of the cases, and varied or cancelled these decisions in whole or in part in 40% of the cases.

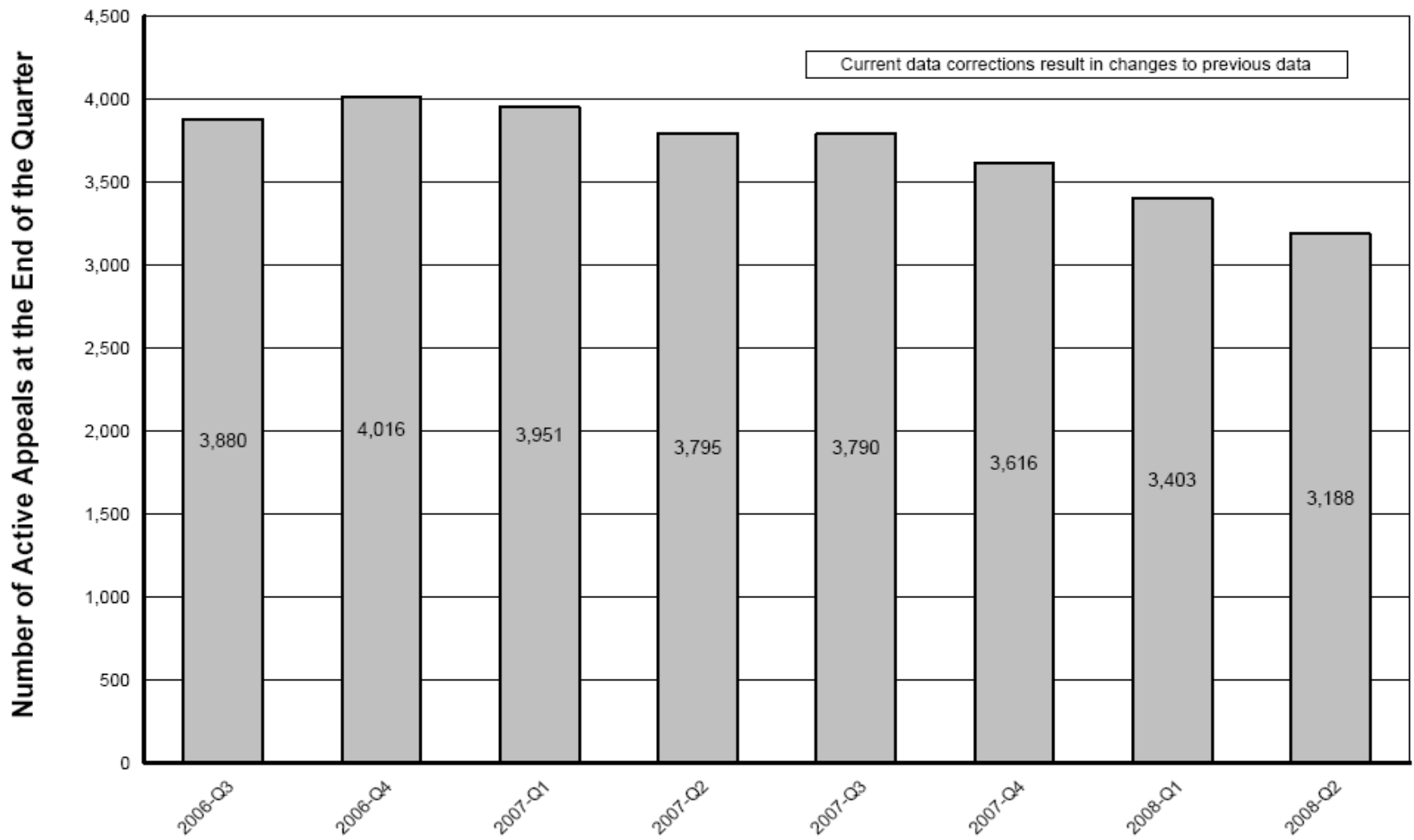
In the second quarter of 2008, our intake amounted to 1,112 appeals. The majority of appeals are compensation appeals.

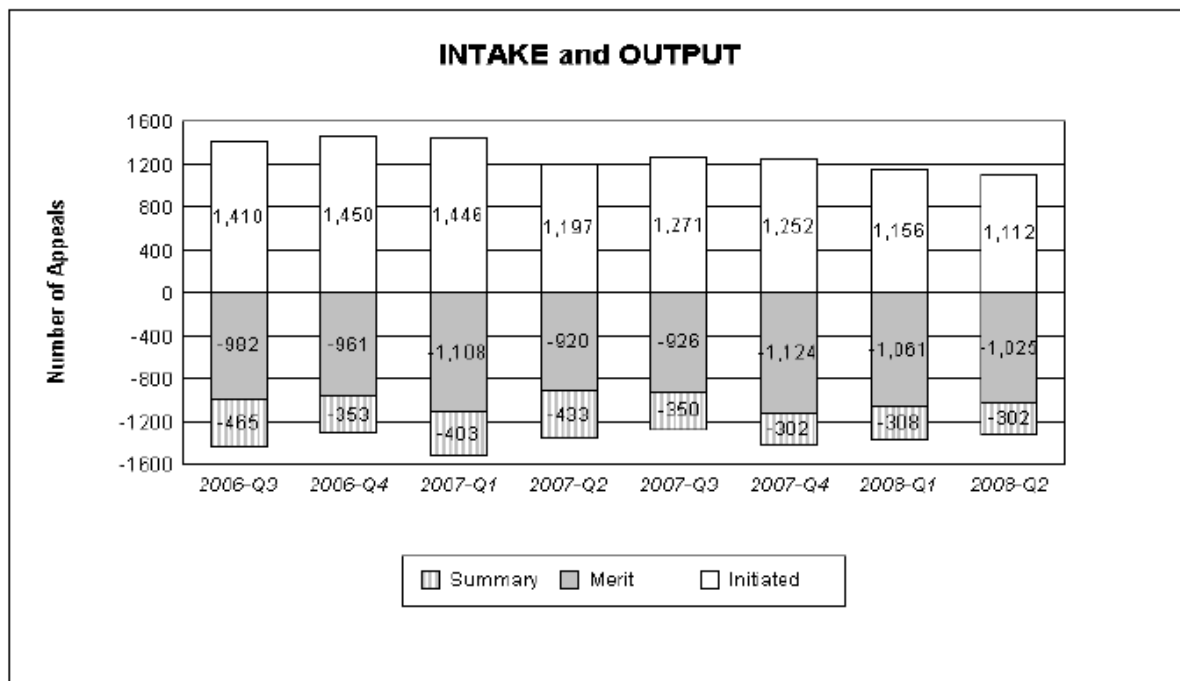
